6.67 rolls needed (extra length for pattern matching already included) + 10% installer buffer (+1.33 rolls) ' 8 rolls to purchase. Buffer covers cutting errors, dye-lot reserve, and leftover gaps you'd otherwise trim and discard.

DYE-LOT CHECK: Confirm every roll shares the same dye-lot number before cutting. Mixed dye-lots produce visible seams that cannot be corrected after hang.

HANG-ORDER QC CHECKLIST

1. Confirm every roll shares the same dye-lot number before any cut.
2. Lay out all numbered strips on the floor in hang order before pasting; verify against the cut table.
3. Mark the kill-point on the wall in pencil and snap a plumb line through it before hanging strip S1.
4. Hang the first three strips dry (no paste) to verify pattern alignment at every seam.
5. After hanging the first papered strip, step back and confirm pattern match against the layout on the floor.
6. Cut openings (doors / windows) on the wall — not in advance — using the dimensions in the cut table.
7. At every roll change, re-confirm dye-lot match and align the new roll's pattern with the previous strip before cutting.
8. Reserve all offcuts > 12" until the job is signed off — they cover unplanned cuts and last-minute repairs.

WALL ELEVATIONS (STRIP LAYOUT)

Walls rendered end-to-end at uniform scale (~23 pt/ft). Strips numbered continuously; red marker shows the kill point (strip 1 start).
